






## **Cultural Study Objectives**

- To learn where & how arts and culture are currently experienced in Newburgh
- To identify barriers to and gaps in arts and cultural participation
- To understand how the community feels arts and culture impact the Newburgh community

To guide decisions that best strengthen and grow the arts and cultural sector



### **Demographic Context**

Newburgh is distinguished by a relatively young and racially diverse population, over half of whom identify as Hispanic/Latino and roughly a quarter as Black. Median income is significantly below the US median.


### **Population and Median Age**

### **Newburgh Strengths**

- Location, size and affordability; Newburgh's proximity to
  New York City and other Hudson Valley attractions.
- Newburgh's extremely diverse population is universally cited as a huge asset.
- Newburgh Pride & Local & homegrown talent: we are a city full of passionate, resilient, resourceful, and driven individuals who are attracted by the opportunity to be part of a solution.
- History-The Aldorf family, former slaves, Underground railroad activists formed the Alsdorf Hall School of music & Dancing.

60% of respondents to the Newburgh Community Cultural Survey strongly agree that arts and culture in Newburgh strengthens community connectivity, provides healing, improves education, and develops our local small business economy.

The arts are Newburgh's **3rd largest employment industry** cluster, creating over 700 jobs since 2013.

### **Arts & Culture**

- Needs to become more inclusive & community centered.
- Become more casual and enjoyable
- Offer content more reflective of people's lives
- Content should be more frequently refreshed





### **4 Strategic Priorities**

- Engage people to celebrate, connect, empower the city's diverse communities.
- Centralize communication, information, and do more robust marketing about arts & culture.
- Improve city gov't support/policies for arts & culture.
  - **Develop additional funding** and financing for the arts & culture.

# **Taking Action**

Concrete actions that we've taken based on the study include:

- A Diverse Arts & Culture commission with 14 members representing the diversity of Newburgh.
- Five 5K grants for artists, and one 5K grant for performance in 2023
- Applying to **Our Town Grant**, \$50-150K to create opportunities to bring communities together and celebrate the arts.
- Created a Community Calendar as a centralized hub for all local arts & cultural events for the city of Newburgh.
  - This year we are doing Hands-On Art To Biz workshops to inspire youth to become involved in creative careers.

# Moving into the Future

- Create an arts and cultural liaison to city government, a position that could be linked to adjacent city needs, i.e. tourism and/or economic development
- Ensure arts and culture are connected and integrated into the city's broader economic development goals.
- **Provide more multipurpose arts venues** (recital halls, theaters, practice spaces), which are key needs currently missing from Newburgh's arts and culture.
- Better **promote and integrate our diversity of cultures**, i.e. by creating a Latino community center or a Black History Museum.
- Foster collaborations & partnerships with higher educational institutions and the Newburgh public schools.
- Support continued growth of creative usinesses, i.e. film, fashion, and <sup>15</sup>
